Bloem Show

New at Bloem Show 2017!

Bloem Show takes place this year from 27th of April to 7th of May and a festival of activities is planned.

For those who always say Bloem Show is always the same, we have news for you this year. There are many new and exciting things in this year's program. There are thus no excuses not to be at Bloem Show this year.

Special rates during Bloem Show

Bloem Show tried to keep rates for 2017 as fair as possible to enable people to visit Bloem Show more than once. So this year there will be two half-price days and a second visit to Bloem Show can be nicely planned. Tickets are available at Computicket outlets or on the Computicket website. Tickets can also be purchased at Bloem Show at the gates. Please note that no "PASSOUTS" will be provided during Bloem Show.

Standard Admission rates for 2017 are as follows:

Feel free to use the OVK entrance (Gate 10) this year with access from Monument Avenue next to the Women's Monument. There visitors get an additional R5 discount on admission. Parking with car guards is also available at Gate 10.

Visitors should note that <u>NO firearms</u> are allowed with access to Bloem Show. Unfortunately, no alcohol or pets are allowed as well.



Amongst the new activities on the Bloem Show program, include:

The 27th of April is the first day of Bloem Show. Plan a wonderful day for the children

- Bloem Show offer a Children's Focus on the 27th of April, the first day of Bloem Show with the popular national production, "Afrikaans gaan klein" in conjunction with Radio Rosestad. *Arno Jordaan, Daisy the storyteller, Lollos, Tjiff and Tjaff, Bella and Buster the dog perform from 11:00 to 12:30*. The crowning of the Little Miss. Bloem Show and Little Miss Daisy also takes place at 17:00.
- For only R5 children can also stand closer and **collect and decorate their own cupcake** at the Farm stall at 10:00 and 15:00.
- Drikus's animal farm is also at Bloem Show this year. Feel free to visit and feed the animals daily at 10:00 and 15:00 until the 5th of May. Their stand is located on the opposite side of the main arena, next to the vegetable tunnel.
- The **Fun Fair** is definitely the children's highlight at Bloem Show. This year visitors can look forward to exciting trips in a festive atmosphere, seating for the parents whom need to rest, thanks to Standard Bank. Many specials are also available this year for the Fun Fair rides. Get your Fun Fair tickets at a 50% discount at Computicket (online or in stores), but only for advance purchases before the 27th of April. During Bloem Show on the 3rd & 4th of May, visitors can purchase special R130 packages for the Fun Fair for unlimited rides until 20:00 the evening. Tickets are available at the Fun Fair ticket office on the day of the special offer.
- A "Kiddies inflatable city" with many inflatable jumping castles and children's rides is also set up this year, across from the entrance to the amusement park. A visit to **The Ark** (formerly the Pet Hall), is a must on the program, camel rides and our extensive exhibition of the SA National Defence Force, are more attractions at Bloem Show which cannot be missed.
- Also visit the agricultural side, for a real **farm experience**. There are several cattle, sheep, horses and goat breed Championships offered during Bloem Show. This can promise any child a very special experience.
- The **Vodacom train** also offers rides through the Showgrounds and can only make the visit a little more fun.
- And for those who are more active, CrossFit offers the **CrossFit Resuelto kiddies competition** on the 27th of April in the Rose Hall at Bloem Show. Continually CrossFit demonstrations are also offered as part of the health and fitness expo. This is in the hall directly across from the Clover Stage.



Other highlights that cannot be missed

- **Sheep Festival on Saturday, 29**th **of April**, with a variety mutton dishes and side dishes (between 12: 00-18: 00) presented by renowned Theunie Kloppers. Buy your ticket at Computicket for R110 and eat as much as you want at Bloem Show. This does not include Bloem Show admission fee for the day.
- On Sunday, 30th of April, in cooperation with Arco Musica, a special performance will take place; "Bloem Show goes Classical" is planning a performance with Arco Musica, Jannie Moolman, Corlea Botha and local singers Cézanne Yzelle, Herman Strauss & Arend Brink Jr. from 13:00- 14:30 at the Computicket stage.
- Pensioners whom celebrate their birthday during Bloem Show this year (27th of April to the 7th of May), can, with the show of their ID document, enjoy a pancake breakfast on any day during the show at the **Pancake King stall** in the Tuliphall, number T20a.
- This year **Car Dealers** are represented in large numbers at Bloem Show. Big names that will be present at Bloem Show this year include, Human Auto, Nissan, Imperial GM, Land Rover, Hyundai, Mahindra and Honda. Many new models will also be on display at the exhibition and **the first launch of the long-awaited Land Rover Discovery is done during Bloem Show from the 27th of April to the 5th of May.**

Farm stall with special demonstrations and exhibitors

- The Free State Red meat producers organisation (RMPO) are once again ensuring that everyone can feast and explore red meat. Come feast on **mutton dishes** and learn from the demonstrations presented by the **Free State RMPO in the Farm Stall tent.**

These tastings will take place between 12:00 to 14:00 daily. The first 50 products for tasting will be offered free of charge. Then visitors pay R10 per taste or R20 to buy the products.
